Accommodations

Participants will be sleeping in rooms usually occupied by students at The Meeting School, who will be away for winter Intersession. There are 2 to 4 single beds per room, with shared bathrooms with hot water and showers. You will need to bring your own bedding (sleeping bag or sheets/blankets, and a pillow). We will not have access to dressers. If you have special needs for sleeping arrangements, please indicate that on your registration form, and we will do our best to accommodate you.

Food

Healthy, home-cooked gourmet meals will be provided by the amazing Tom Morris, an intern at TMS who has graduated from culinary school. Vegetarian fare will be available at every meal, and other dietary needs can be met if we notify Tom in advance.

HOW TO REACH THE MEETING SCHOOL

The Meeting School is just off US Route 202 in Rindge in southwest New Hampshire.

From Boston Area: From Logan Airport, if you're unfamiliar with Boston driving, take Interstate 90 (the Mass. Turnpike; it begins at the airport) out of Boston to Interstate 95 North (Mass. Rt 128), then on I-95 take Exit 29B onto Mass. Rt 2 West. Follow Rt 2 around Concord and out to Interstate 495 north.

From Interstate 495 N: Take exit 31 onto Mass. Rt 119; follow 119 through the village centers of Groton, Townsend, and Ashby, into New Hampshire and Rindge. At 35.5 miles (about 50 minutes) from I-495, Rt 119 intersects US Rt 202 at a traffic light with a Citgo station; turn left (south) and

* Go half a mile through another light, to turn right on Thomas Road. Go 3/10 of a mile to a stop sign; turn right, then turn right again into the first driveway at the Office sign.

From the northeast (Concord & Manchester, NH; Maine): From Manchester Airport, follow the exit road to Interstate 293 and head west/north, then follow the signs for NH Rt 101 to Peterborough. From Concord, take Interstate 89 & US 202 to Peterborough. Then take Route 202 South through Jaffrey to Rindge. At the junction of 202 with NH Rt 119, remain on 202 south and continue from *

From the west and south: Take any of Interstates 90 (from New York state or western Mass.) or 95, 84, or 91 (from New York city or Connecticut) to Interstate 91 north in Massachusetts. Once on Interstate 91 northbound in Mass.: after Greenfield, take exit 28A (for Route 10/Northfield); follow Route 10 East & North for 12.5 miles through Northfield, MA to Winchester, NH; turn right on Route 119 East, continue about 19 scenic miles to junction with US Route 202 in Rindge at a traffic light with a Citgo gas station. Turn right on Rt 202 South and continue from *

From Vermont, Montreal, Quebec, & Ottawa: Interstate 91 south; after Bellows Falls take Exit 5 and go east to US Rt 5; turn right & follow Rt 5 South to VT Rt 123 into NH. After crossing the Connecticut River, turn right on NH Rt 12. Follow Route 12 southeast about 30 miles, passing through Keene and Troy to Fitzwilliam. Turn left onto NH Route 119 East (at a flashing yellow light with a Mobil gas station), and continue 6 miles east to US Rt 202 in Rindge (traffic light, Citgo station); turn right onto 202 S. Continue from *

By air: Use Manchester Airport in NH or Boston's Logan Airport. TMS makes a scheduled pickup at Manchester on major vacations, and students can use Boston's train service to get from Logan to TMS.

By train: Amtrack serves Boston's South Station (and North Station, from Maine). From North Station students can take Boston's MBTA Commuter Rail to Fitchburg, where TMS makes scheduled pickups.

By bus: Greyhound serves Keene, NH on routes from NY, VT, and Canada.
